

Workshop by Northern Ireland – LTTA Spain May 2018

PARTICIPANTS – 20 Grade 6 pupils, European partners, teachers

Duration – 1hr 30

OBJECTIVE – To introduce the Spanish pupils and teachers to the many wonderful tourist attractions in Northern Ireland. Explore places of historical and cultural interest, such as Giant's Causeway and teach the importance of Finn Mac Cool in Irish legend.

To develop and enrich pupils' knowledge of Northern Ireland's myths and legends.

ACTIVITIES

Show pupils and teachers power point of Finn Mac Cool and his link with the Giant's Causeway.

Question and answer session based on power point visual stimuli

PUPIL ACTIVITY – ASSEMBLE A TEMPLATE OF FINN MAC COOL

Children are given a template of Finn Mac Cool and suitable mythical clothing, which they have to design in line with tradition. When this is completed children have to cut their templates out and assemble using paper fasteners, and in turn dress Finn Mac Cool.

GALLERY SESSION

Pupils display their finished Finn Mac Cools for peers and European visitors.

OUTCOMES

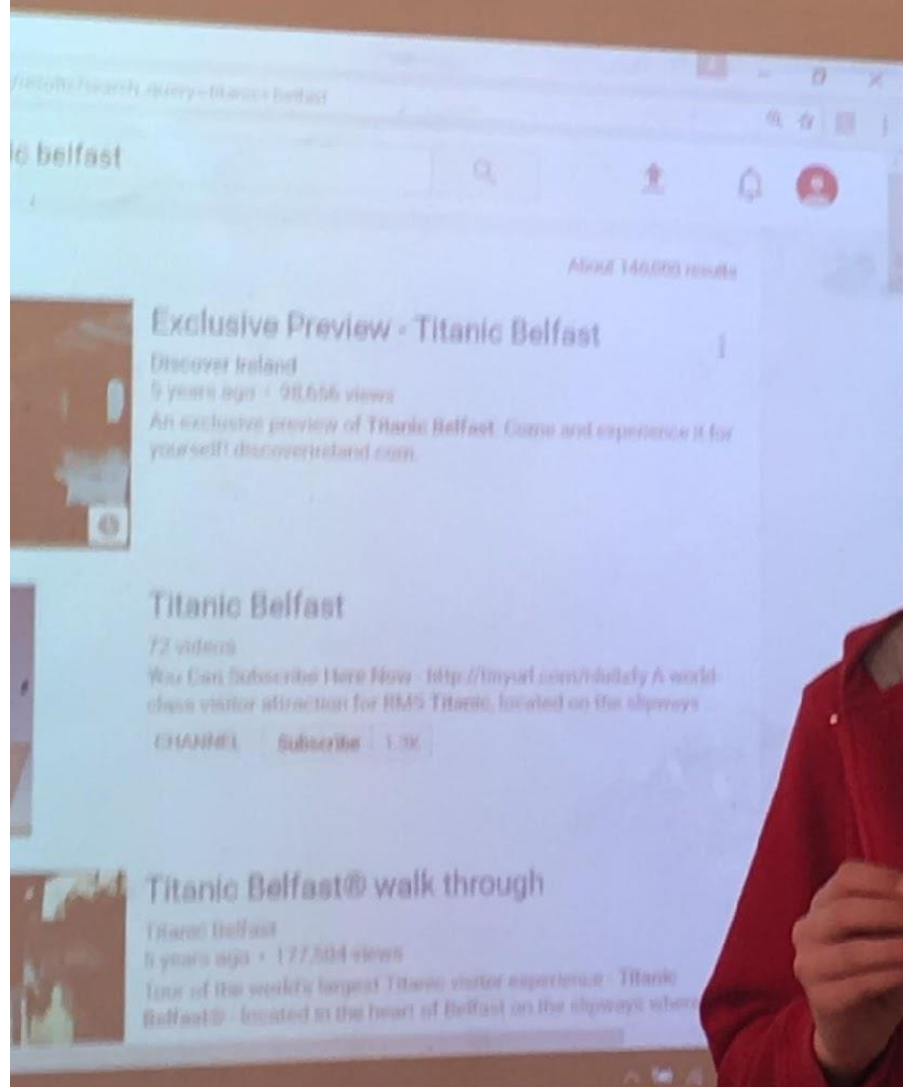
Lesson proved to be a great success. Partners and participants had many opportunities to develop their spoken English through discussions about Finn Mac Cool and listening to modelled English speakers.

Pupils were introduced to new vocabulary and were encouraged to use this in discussions with their peers and partners.

Pupils have a better knowledge of myths and legends and the importance of Finn Mac Cool as part of our Irish cultural heritage and his significance to the Giant's Causeway.

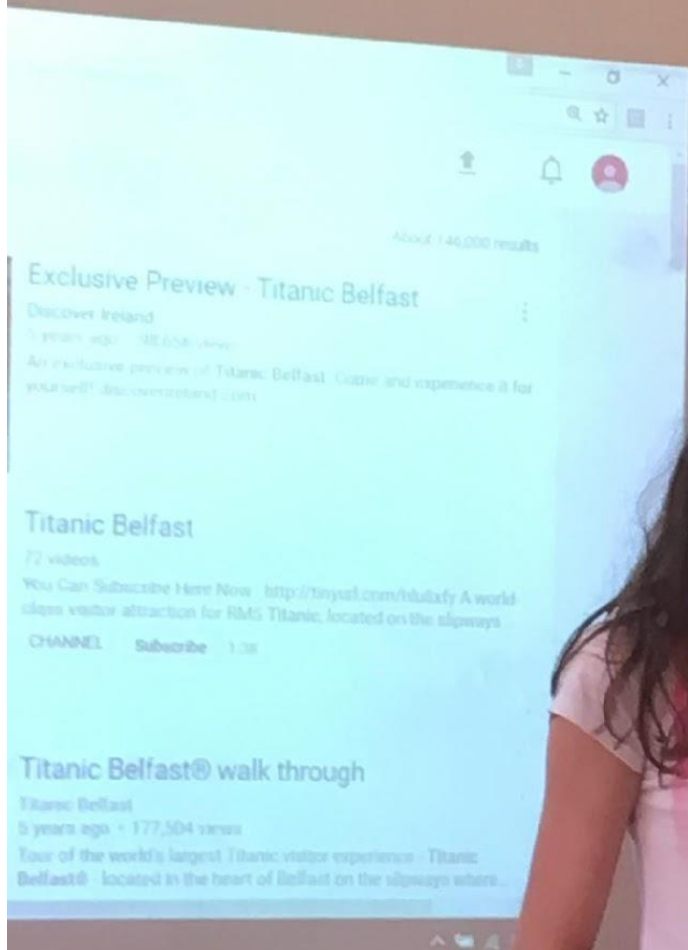
