

MINUTES of LTTA IN ZAGREB APRIL 2019

This Learning, Teaching and Training activity was hosted in Zagreb, Croatia from 1st to 5th April 2019. Under the Erasmus+ programme and the Cultural Art for the Development of European Education project -@museart. The participants that attended were the following ones:

Bulgaria (3 teachers), Spain (2 teachers), Estonia (2 teachers), England (3 teachers), Italy (5 teachers and 6 students), Ireland (4 teachers), Northern Ireland (3 teachers) and Sweden (3 teachers). The overall aim of this LTTA was to meet our project partners again in a meeting, to participate in and the trial of the "School for life".

The main idea was to share and learn from our European colleagues with some workshops, activities, examples and experiences related to Art.

During those days as a school coordinator, we have had the additional responsibility of combining final products and project growth. That's why we were involved in doing some workshops which were indicators of achievement of our main goals in the @museart project in the last LTTA.

The details of this visit are the following ones:

1st day-Visit to City Zagreb: walking tour, visiting some of the most important parts of the city center with a coffee break. We finished up taking the tram to our Primary school Ivana Cankara. Teachers arrived to the school and students performed our school's anthem. Later on, 7th grade students showed our school to the Erasmus teachers. That day teachers from Ireland, Spain, Sweden and N. Ireland had prepared some workshops based on different activities such as presentations, songs, dances...for our students. All of them were very interesting and they followed different methodologies and ways of learning.

After lunch we went by bus to visit the castle "Trakošćan" and we participated in a workshop from in Marija Bistrica making licitar hearts which is on the UNESCO list.

3rd day-

That day teachers from Bulgaria, Italy, England and Estonia had prepared some workshops based on different activities such as presentations, songs, dances...for our students.

Then in the afternoon we went by bus and visited Plitvice Lakes which is on the UNESCO list.

4th day

We met in the morning in front of the hotel and travelled to the island Krk. We have seen village Jurandvor and the "Bašćanska" panel from the 11th century. One of the most valuable national and cultural monuments of the Croatian people and its language.

We visited the observatory in Rijeka too.

5th day

In the morning, Italian students were at school.

According to their interest, they could've spend their morning at school or visit the museums.

Our school hosted the last LTTA project meeting and we had the pleasure to host 25 teachers and 6 Italian students and to share with all of them some part of our local culture and history.
